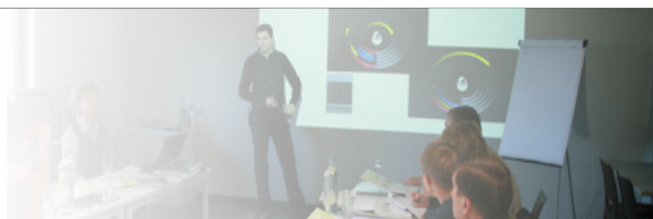

1. TRAINING

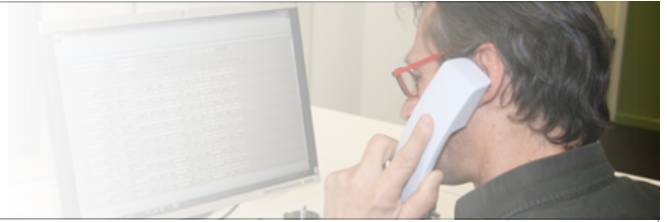


- Intensive four-day training course at the Petersime Incubation Performance Centre for the hatchery manager or his assistant
- Covering a range of technical and physiological topics, including the operation of the incubator controller and the principle of Embryo-Response Incubation™
- Introduction to the comprehensive Incubation Guide, covering all machinery related issues and outlining the entire incubation process from start to finish

2. REMOTE SUPERVISION



- The hatchery manager sends Incubation Guide feedback forms to the Petersime Incubation Performance Centre in Belgium at regular intervals.
- Based on this information, a member of the Petersime Incubation Performance Centre remotely supervises the project and provides recommendations to achieve better results.

3. VISIT OF HGP SUPERVISOR



Your Petersime Hatchery Guidance Programme Supervisor visits your hatchery for the following tasks:

- Verification of the soundness of the installation
- Additional on-site training for the hatchery manager and his staff
- Assistance with egg-setting and analysis of loaded setters and hatchers during the start-up period
- Set-up of a detailed report containing 'to-dos' for both Petersime and the hatchery staff

4. ANALYSIS OF HATCH RESULTS



The Petersime Hatchery Guidance Programme Supervisor returns to the hatchery to analyse the hatch results from the egg-setting visit.

- Analysis of hatch results
- Collection of additional information
- Recommendations for the next settings
- Meeting with the hatchery manager and his technical staff to discuss the feedback report

5. CLOSING VISIT



- A meeting with the hatchery's CEO/General Manager/Owner is organized by the Petersime Area Sales Manager and distributor.
- A status report is drawn up with actions performed and results achieved.
